DIAPERS FOR CRISIS PREGNANCIES IN HAIFA

14 boxes of diapers and a carton of new baby outfits were delivered to a pro-life association in



Haifa in the north of Israel. These diapers and clothing are being given to pregnant women who have been given information and made the decision to keep their babies. Having the diapers and new clothing on hand to provide these women in great need contributes greatly to their belief that they will make it through.

The Haifa Pro-Life Aid Center, run by Marvin and Orit, educates in the schools as well as helps the many women

in crisis pregnancies. Haifa has had a large influx of immigrants in the last ten years and poverty levels have risen. Thank you to Friends of Love to the Needy for helping to bring these diapers to the needy in Israel.

SUPPLIES FOR THE DISABLED IN SDEROT

Eleven cartons of incontinence supplies for the disabled in the Gaza Strip border city of



Sderot in southern Israel were delivered to the Sderot Aid center. Stewart, who manages the center, talks about the residents of Sderot who have been financially unable to move out of the city, and life "under the bombs". Everyone who could moved out of the city many years ago, yet hundreds of Ethiopian new immigrants have been placed in the district. There is also an Orthodox Jewish community in the city that staunchly refuses to leave, even though the residents of the city mostly all have PTSD (Post Traumatic Stress Disorder). This causes inability to go into deep sleep, and craziness in the daytime



due to lack of good sleep, forgetfulness, etc. Sometimes people jump when they

hear a loud sound, even when it is not a "Red Dawn" alert of an incoming bomb. Any help that can be given to this city is clearly appreciated by the residents, many of whom are unemployed. These incontinence supplies are expensive here in Israel, and this gift was a huge one for the city.

COUNTERING POVERTY IN HAIFA



In answer to the struggling need in the northern Israeli city of Haifa, Love to the Needy delivered 100 cartons of quality, second-hand clothing to the Springs Aid Center in the city.

This aid station, run by Victor, has been operating for many years and serves hundreds of Ukrainian new immigrants each month. The immigrants who come to Israel usually come with only two suitcases to their name. They must learn Hebrew in order to get decent work, and mostly do not have employment. By



word of mouth they find the Springs Aid Center.



They are allowed to pick up a certain number of clothing items each month for each family member. Most importantly, relationships are formed with new immigrants, friendships develop, and fellowship is created in the new Land.
